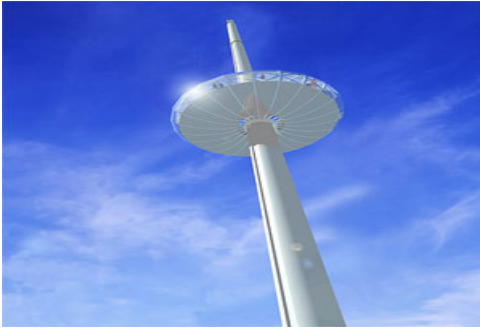


New Developments

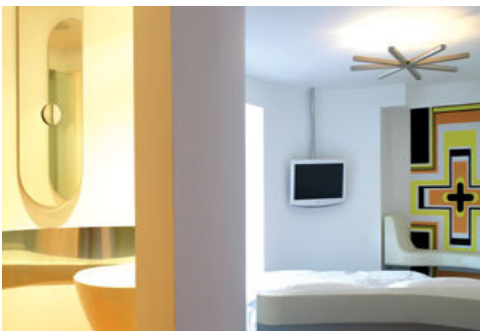


- **The Brighton i-360** observation tower designed by the award-winning architects of the London Eye is due to open in 2009. It will carry up to 100 visitors at a time in an aerodynamically designed pod, 183 metres above sea level www.westpier.co.uk.



- **New restaurants** have been popping up across the city including a second Riddle & Finns in Hove, delicious homemade ice cream from Scoop & Crumb and Jamie Oliver will be opening a Pukka Pasta in the summer of 2008

- **New hotels** continue to be built across the city, including an ultra-modern myhotel in early 2008 www.myhotels.co.uk. - **The New England Quarter** is a contemporary village, which will feature a language school, shops, and a public square as well as two new hotels including a 249 room Jury's Inn which opened in Nov 2007 www.jurysinns.com / www.new-england-quarter.co.uk

- **Frank Gehry** has designed a new leisure complex for Hove, which will have two futuristic towers, three swimming pools, a sports hall and a health and fitness suite with gym www.thekingalfred.org



- **Brighton Marina** is set to be transformed with a 28-storey Marina Point tower with a pack of cards design and a 40-storey building further out to sea. Plus a new Harbour Square to make the Marina entrance more attractive www.brightonmarina.co.uk
